

GSHA RULES COMMITTEE REPORT
AUGUST 17, 2019

Before reporting on 2019, it is appropriate to give members a brief review of the work performed by the GSHA Rules Committee in 2018. The Committee consisted of the following members: Jeanette Martinez, Chair, GSHA-SC, Abel Santistevan, Former Chair, FACC; Dr. Sunny Vazquez McMullen, GSHA-SC and John Vasquez, FACC.

In 2018 the GSHA Rules committee received 48 proposed bylaws changes; 15 were voted on and incorporated into the current GSHA Bylaws.

In 2019, no new proposed bylaws amendments were received. Of the original 48 proposed bylaws changes received in 2018, 15 more were presented to the GSHA membership to vote on via the e-voting website, Simply Voting. The vote was held beginning at noon July 10, 2019 and ending at 9:00 pm, July 25, 2019.

Hard copy ballots were mailed to 22 GSHA households who don't have email. Of those, eight ballots were returned.

Electronic votes: Out of 279 GSHA member households, 97 votes were received.

Approximately one-third of GSHA's 300+ members voted.

The results of the electronic vote are: All 15 proposed bylaws changes passed.
Results of the US mail votes are: All 15 proposed bylaws changes passed.

The GSHA Board of Directors and the Rules Committee would like to thank all members who made the effort to cast their votes.
